Therapeutic Formulas

The following formulas are specialized for medical conditions such as failure to thrive and cow's milk protein allergies. We must have a prescription/referral signed by a MD, NP or PA with a valid medical condition.

CHILDREN 1 YEAR AND OLDER	INDICATION(S)/DIAGNOSIS
PediaSure Vanilla 8 fl oz Ready-to-Feed	Provides additional calories for children with food restrictions, additional dietary support for children with lactose and gluten intolerance. WIC can issue up to 3 bottles/day. Please note: Pediasure cannot be provided for 'picky eating' since it is not a medical diagnosis. If you have a patient who may be considered a "picky eater" you may refer them to one of our registered dietitians or degreed nutritionists who are able to provided individualized nutrition counseling to improve their intake.
